### Yard Waste

**Yard Waste will be picked up on the first and third Tuesday April through Oct.**

Please place yard waste in a brown paper LAWN WASTE bag.

You may place as many bags of yard waste at the curb as needed with no additional charge.

Branches need to be bundled when not placed in a bag. Branches must be no longer than three foot in length and be no more than three inches in diameter.

Metal - aluminum beverage containers, steel food containers, soup and food tin cans

**69.07 PARKING PROHIBITED.** No one shall stop, stand or park a vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a peace officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

6. Intersection. Within an intersection or within ten (10) feet of an intersection of any street or alley. (Code of Iowa, Sec.
